

Intrastate Personal Transportation of Marijuana & Marijuana-Paraphernalia and Products



Intrastate personal transportation of marijuana and marijuana products are permitted for eligible individuals in the state of Montana. This document has been created as a guide for local and state law enforcement to assist in determining what constitutes personal, legal transportation.

- Personal possession amounts are per <u>MCA 16-12-106</u>:
  - Up to 1 ounce of usable marijuana:
    - ✓ 1 ounce of marijuana flower;
    - ✓ 800 milligrams of THC-infused marijuana products;
    - ✓ 8 grams of marijuana concentrate.
- Interstate travel is prohibited for adult consumers and registered cardholders.
- Eligible individuals may travel in a non-commercial vehicle with their marijuana/paraphernalia as follows:
  - In a motor vehicle's locked glove compartment or storage compartment;
  - In a motor vehicle's trunk or luggage compartment;
  - In a truck bed or cargo compartment;
  - Behind the last upright seat of a motor vehicle that is not equipped with a trunk; and,
  - In a closed container in the area of a motor vehicle that is not equipped with a trunk and that is not normally occupied by the driver or passenger.
  - A violation of this rule is a civil penalty per MCA 61-8-1027.
    - ✓ A violation of this section is not a criminal offense; it is a civil offense.

- ✓ The violation may not be recorded against the driver's record.
- A motor vehicle insurance company may not hold a violation of this section against the insured or increase premiums because of the violation.
- Per <u>MCA 61-8-1002</u>, a person commits the offense of driving under the influence if the person drives or is in actual physical control of a vehicle (non-commercial and commercial) while consuming marijuana/marijuana products and/or having five (5) nanograms per milliliter (5ng/ml) or more Delta-9 THC in their blood or other bodily substance.
