Section 5 – Declaration and Affidavit

We understand that only table wine that has been blended or fermented at our licensed premises can only be sold and consumed within the enclosure where the event is held and only on the above date(s). We declare that the location of the event is not within 600 feet and on the same street as a school or church. We understand the special permit allows us to sell our products that have been fermented or blended at our licensed premises for off premises consumption if sold in its original packaging.

We will follow all the laws, rules and ordinances relating to the sale of table wine. We understand that a violation of any law or rule relating to the sale of table wine will be reason to revoke the permit. Any authorized employee of the department, its representative or any peace officer will have the right to examine the location of the event at any time.
