\$8,200	\$11,100	4% of taxable income	\$167

\$14,300	\$18,400	6% of taxable income	\$421
	More than \$18,400	6.9% of taxable income	\$587

Example:

Your taxable income is \$25,000.

 $25,000 \times 6.9\% (0.069) = 1,725$

\$1,725 - \$587 = \$1,138 tax
