

Property Tax Exemption Application for Installation of an Alternative Energy System

AB-14 V3 6/2022

The installation cost of an alternative energy system in a residential and nonresidential property may be eligible for a property tax exemption for ten years if the system meets the requirements of <u>15-6-224</u>, <u>MCA</u> and <u>ARM 42.19.1104</u>.

Submit a completed application to your local Department of Revenue field office by March 1 to be considered for the current tax year.

We will review your application and contact you to schedule a property visit to inspect the energy system.
